Wednesday September 18

For many of our travelers it is departure day, for the overnight transatlantic flight to France. Some travelers may choose to leave for Europe sooner to extend the start of the trip - let us know if we can quote you on pre-tour accommodations. Guests who have other travels already in progress, or guests from other points of origin including the United Kingdom, the United States and elsewhere, will meet the start of the tour on Day 1 in Paris.

Day 1 - Thursday September 19

In the mid-afternoon all clients can check into the group hotel. In the meantime, luggage is stored in the hotel baggage lock-up. Today you are free to explore Paris, one of the great capital cities of Europe. In the early evening we gather in the heart of Paris for our Welcome Dinner, to share a glass and set the stage for our special journey. Overnight Paris. [D]

Day 2 - Friday September 20

Depart for the Normandy coast to consider pre D-Day 'Atlantic Wall' defenses including the Longues-sur-Mer coastal gun battery; tour the Memorial Pegasus Museum followed by a walk to the Café Gondrée. Overnight Caen. [B]

Day 3 - Saturday September 21

Morning walk along the sands of Juno Beach, followed by a tour of the Juno Beach Centre including the German bunkers; see Canada House on the beach at Bernières-sur-Mer; visit the coast at Saint-Aubin. Overnight Caen. [B,L]

Day 4 - Sunday September 22

Visit British landing zone at Gold Beach and the Mulberry Harbour at Arromanches, including the Musée du Débarquement; Omaha American Landing Beach; Pointe-du-Hoc; La Cambe German War Cemetery. Overnight Caen. [B,L]

Day 5 - Monday September 23

We'll visit Bény-sur-Mer Canadian War Cemetery, and the Abbey Ardennes, before carrying onward up the coast. Overnight Dieppe. [B]

ITINERARY

Day 6 - Tuesday September 24

Tour the Dieppe main beach to consider Operation Jubilee, followed by visits to the beaches at Puys and Pourville; Dieppe Canadian War Cemetery.

Overnight Amiens (Poulainville). [B]

Day 7 - Wednesday September 25

Walk the fields of the Battle of the Somme at Beaumont-Hamel Newfoundland Park; visits to the Thiepval Memorial, Lochnagar Crater and the monument at Courcelette. Overnight Arras. [B,L]

Day 8 - Thursday September 26

We spend the morning at the Canadian National Vimy Memorial, standing proud on the highest point of Vimy Ridge. In the afternoon we visit the War Graves Commission's factory in Beaurains, where the headstones are engraved with reverence and care. Overnight Arras. [B,L]

Day 9 - Friday September 27

We continue our exploration of the WW1 and the importance of the battles in what has become known as 'Canada's 100 Days.' We also continue our journey along the Trail of the Caribou. Overnight Arras. [B,L]

Day 10 - Saturday September 28

We visit the monument to Canadian George Lawrence Price, the last soldier of the British Empire to die in The Great War. Free time for lunch in historic Mons. Overnight Ieper (Ypres). [B]

Day 11 - Sunday September 29

We will tour the Ypres Salient with visits to Hill 62, the Passchendaele, The Brooding Solider at St. Julien, Essex Farm, and Tyne Cot Cemetery; free afternoon in Ieper to relax and explore; optional evening attendance at the inspiring Last Post Ceremony. Overnight Ieper (Ypres). [B]

Day 12 - Monday September 30

Explore the Breskens Pocket with visits to the Leopold Canal, Eede, Hickman's Bridge, the monuments at Hoofdplaat and more, along with a special visit to the Canada-Poland Museum in Adegem. Overnight Vlissingen. [B,L]

Day 13 - Tuesday October 1

Discover the Scheldt Estuary campaign as we make visits in Woensdrecht, Bergen op Zoom, and more. Following our Farewell Lunch near the German border we visit Groesbeek War Cemetery, then continue onward to Amsterdam. Overnight Amsterdam. [B,L]

Day 14 - Wednesday October 2

Enjoy a free day at your leisure exploring one of Europe's great capital cities, with its UNESCO World Heritage canals. Overnight Amsterdam. [B]

Day 15 - Thursday October 3

This morning is departure day for those returning home - a buffet or box breakfast is included depending on departure time from the hotel. Some travelers may choose to remain in Europe longer to extend their trip - let us know if we can quote you on post-tour accommodations. [B]

Itinerary is subject to minor change prior to departure. Minor variances are also possible during the actual tour based on the need to adapt to circumstances we may encounter during our travels.

THE TOUR.

Juno Beach

Stand on the very shore where Canadians stormed the beaches on D-Day, June 6, 1944. Learn how the Canadians made it further inland than any other allied force. Your visit includes a guided tour of the beaches and a tour of the Juno Beach Centre. It's a little piece of Canada on the French coast.



Paris

Enjoy some time unwinding as you absorb Paris in the spring! There's so much to see, including the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral, the Louvre, the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs-Élysées, Les Jardins du Luxembourg, the list goes on!

THE TRIP.



Vimv Ridae

The ground that could not be taken and held ... until the Canadians came. For the first time, all four divisions of the Canadian Expeditionary Force will fight together, and their success of April 1917 resonates still to this day. See what many consider the most beautiful of all the war monuments in Europe, a symbol of peace.



leper (Ypres)

Enjoy a little free time for shopping and a lot of great food, or perhaps a walk along the old city ramparts and cobblestone streets. Here you'll often cross paths with other battlefield tourists from Canada, the United Kingdom and more. The evening Last Post Ceremony is a very special highlight of any visit to leper, a tradition that continues since 1928.



Passchendaele

It's been called the ugliest fight of both World Wars. It's October 1917 and the Canadians will suffer gas attacks, infested trenches, misery. And yet they will once again prevail. What was then a barren, muddy landscape is now a quiet, lovely countryside. You'll see where they fought, and where John McCrae wrote his famous poem.



War Graves Cemeteries

The war cemeteries are places of serenity. They are immaculately maintained by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission, which commemorates 1.7 million soldiers, sailors and airmen from two world wars. They are peaceful places, and they beckon you to visit.



Beaumont-Hamel

Many Canadians don't know the name but Beaumont-Hamel is forever etched into the memory of Newfoundlanders. It was here in July 1916 that a thousand soldiers climbed up out of the trenches and into the gunfire, and were almost completely wiped out. They are the Royal Newfoundland Regiment and their battleground is renowned as one of the best preserved WWI sites in all of France.



Amsterdam

You will round out your fabulous trip with two nights in the beautiful city of Amsterdam. It's 17th century canals are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You may wish to visit the Rijksmuseum, the House of Anne Frank, or simply sit at a canal-side café enjoying coffee while watching the people go by.
